

All about western box turtles

The western box turtle is 4 to 5 inches long. Also the western box turtle has two red eyes. It also has a really cool shell by the shape. And the head bob's up and down which I think is funny.



The western box turtle spends most of his time on land but that dose not mean they are tortoises. These turtles are found in Texas, Southern Arizona and Mexico.





The western box turtle eats small insects, worms and vegetation. Vegetations are plants.



The females lay 3 to 7 eggs in the sand. The eggs take about 10 days to hatch. The western box turtle has a hinged shell that can close over the turtles head in defense.
