

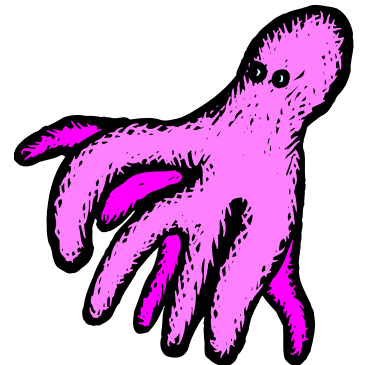
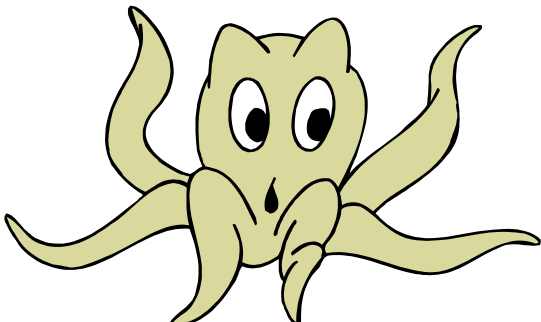
The Giant Pacific Octopus
